Our very own Christ Church Choir are the Musicians in Residence at Bristol Cathedral and Westminster Abbey this week from August 14-25, singing daily Choral Evensong and the Sunday Eucharist. What an exciting opportunity for Christ Church and its choir! Bruce Barber leads the choir in their residency, while Ruth Beresford leads the choral pilgrimage. This rich musical and spiritual journey allows pilgrims to hear our choir in these magnificent places of worship, along with some of the finest choirs in England sing Evensong daily while exploring the cathedrals, chapels, and towns in which they perform. In addition to daily choral worship, this is also a time to build relationships and share stories with fellow travelers, bonding over shared meals and along England's carriageways.
